

Notice is given that Cambridgeshire County Council intends after seven days, to make the following Orders pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the effect of which:

**Cambridge Road (A10), Foxton
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2014/141**

Is to stop any vehicle from proceeding along Cambridge Road (A10), Foxton as lies between points 20m either side of the railway level crossing situated there and as measured from its gates or barriers.

The alternative route for vehicles will be via A10 – Station Road – Newton Road – Harston Road – B1368 – Long Lane – Shepreth Road – A10 and vice versa.

The proposed Order is necessary to facilitate essential maintenance works which are being carried out on or near this highway and it will come into operation on 11 September 2014 and continue until those works have finished or on the 10 March 2015 whichever is the earlier.

It is anticipated that these works will be carried out overnight 23:00hrs 11 September and 05:00hrs 12 September 2014.

**Cambridge Road (A10), Foxton
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2014/173**

Is to stop any vehicle from proceeding along Cambridge Road (A10), Foxton as lies between points 20m either side of the railway level crossing situated there and as measured from its gates or barriers.

The alternative route for vehicles will be via A10 – Station Road – Newton Road – Harston Road – B1368 – Long Lane – Shepreth Road – A10 and vice versa.

The proposed Order is necessary to facilitate essential maintenance works which are being carried out on or near this highway and it will come into operation on 26 October 2014 and continue until those works have finished or on the 25 April 2015 whichever is the earlier.

Is to stop any vehicle from proceeding along Pemberton Terrace, Cambridge as lies between Panton Street and Brookside.

The alternative route for vehicles is via Panton Street – A603 – Brookside – Bateman Street – Panton Street – Pemberton Terrace.

The proposed Order is necessary to facilitate gas main renewal works which are being carried out on or near this highway and it will come into operation on 1 September 2014 and continue until these works have finished or on the 28 February 2015 whichever is the earlier.

It is anticipated that these works will be carried out between 1 September and 19 September 2014.

**Radegund Road, Perne Road and Birdwood Road, Cambridge

Is to stop any vehicle from proceeding along Radegund Road, Perne Road and Birdwood Road, Cambridge as lies at the Radegund Road roundabout, Cambridge.

The alternative route for vehicles is via A1307 – A603 – A1134 and vice versa OR Mill Road – Coleridge Road – Cherry Hinton Road and vice versa.

The proposed Order is necessary to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works which are being carried out on or near this highway and it will come into operation on 7 September 2014 and continue until these works have finished or on the 6 March 2015 whichever is the earlier.

It is anticipated that these works will be carried out on Sunday's 7 September and 14 September 2014.

**Bene't Street, Cambridge
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC)**

Is to stop any vehicle from proceeding along Bene't Street, Cambridge as lies between Trumpington Street and Peas Hill.

During the period this Order remains in force Schedule 6 (One Way Streets) of the City of Cambridge Area Z (Consolidation) Order 1991 (Amendment No. 11) Order 1995 is hereby suspended insofar as it Bene't Street.
