THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2013
(AMENDMENT NO. 115) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that Cambridgeshire County Council proposes to make the above named Order under the powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (as amended).

The effect of this Order will be to introduce No Waiting at any time on the following roads in Cambridge:-

- Abbey Street on the west side from its northern end for 35m in a southerly direction;
- Robert May Close on the north side from its junction with Tiverton Way for 28m in a generally easterly direction, and on its south side from the same junction for 31m in the same direction;
- Britten Place on both sides from its junction with Tiverton Way for 15m in an easterly direction;
- Tiverton Way on its east side from a point in line with the boundary of nos.17 and 19 Tiverton Way in a southerly direction to a point in line with the boundary of no.1 Britten Place and no.15 Tiverton Way;
- Birch Close on both sides from its junction with Milton Road for 33m in a north-westerly direction;
- Orchard Street on the north side from a point in line with the boundary of no.1 Orchard Street and no.18 Emmanuel Road for 106m in an easterly direction and on the south side from the same point for 105m in the same direction (replaces existing no waiting Mon-Sat 9am-5pm on those two lengths of Orchard St);
- Beaumont Road on both sides from its junction with Queen Edith's Way for 19m in a southerly direction;
- Netherhall Road on both sides from its junction with Beaumont Road for 20m in a westerly direction, on the north side from a point 7m west of the boundary of nos.52 and 54 for 24m in a westerly direction and on the south side from a point in line with the boundary of nos.81 and 83 for 26m in an easterly direction;
- Chalk Grove on both sides from its junction with Netherhall Road for 20m in a northerly direction;
- Campkin Road from a point in line with the boundary of nos.36 and 38 for 32m in a westerly direction.

In addition, this Order will introduce No Waiting Mon-Fri 9am-5pm on the following roads:-

- Netherhall Road on the north side from 20m west of its junction with Beaumont Road for 189m in a westerly direction and from 9m east of the boundary of nos.56 and 58 for 99m in a westerly direction.

The draft Order, together with a plan showing the roads and lengths of road concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at Reception, Shire Hall, Castle Hill, Cambridge CB3 0AP during normal office hours.
